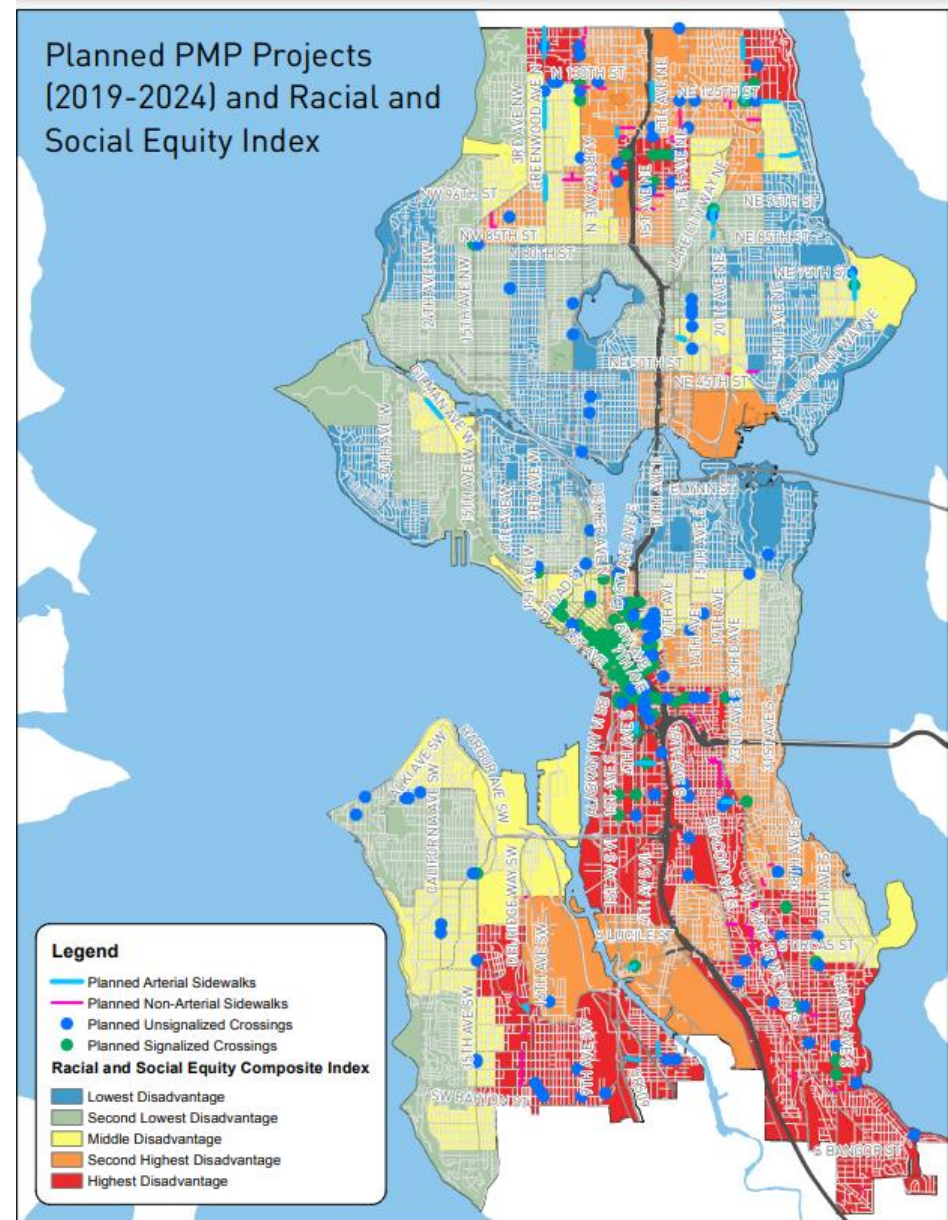
Build on existing practices to center equity in Levy delivery by centralizing and standardizing how we incorporate equity into Levy program prioritization frameworks
